



NSW PRE-ELECTION BUDGET UPDATE RELEASED

As required by section 24 of the *Parliamentary Budget Officer Act 2010*, the Secretary of NSW Treasury released the NSW Pre-election Budget Update following the commencement of caretaker.

The report provides updated information on the current and projected financial position of the New South Wales general government sector.

This is the first time the State has released a Pre-election Budget Update.

The Pre-election Budget Update includes:

- the revised projections for the current financial year
- the revised forward estimates for major aggregates over three years
- the latest economic projections for the current financial year and the three years for which the revised forward estimates are provided
- an explanation of any significant variation in the revised projections, forward estimates or economic projections that were contained in the previous half-yearly budget review or budget
- revised financial statements for the general government sector for the current financial year and the three years for which the revised forward estimates are provided,
- an update of any matter required to be included in the budget papers by section 8 (b) of the *Fiscal Responsibility Act 2012*.
